



Reception	To listen and respond to stories and ask questions. To know about special places, people, and books.
Year 1	To begin to make links between place, people, and books with the religions. To ask questions and respond to experiences. To recognise symbols.
Year 2	To respond respectfully to similarities and differences within religions and retell stories from different religions.
Year 3	To describe connections between features of different religions. To learn more about festivals and worship.
Year 4	To explore and describe beliefs, symbols, and actions so they understand different ways of life and express meaning.
Year 5	To discuss and justify their own views, making links to beliefs and religions, while responding respectfully to the views of others.
Year 6	To be aware of challenges that people face, understand world- wide views and can identify why belonging to a faith community may be valuable.
