In autumn the weather starts to get colder and the days get shorter.

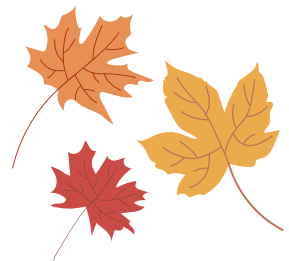
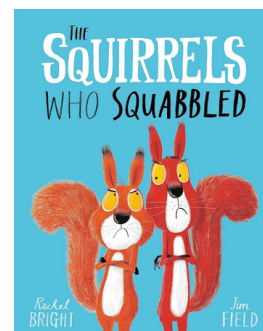
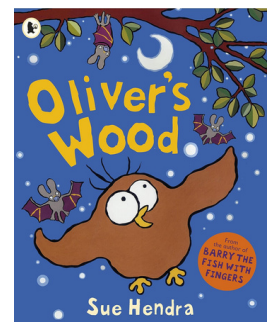
