Murphy Class Trip to All Things Wild, Honeybourne **Wednesday 7th May 2025**

Dear Parents & Carers

We are very excited to announce that we have arranged a trip for Murphy Class to All Things Wild, in Honeybourne, on Wednesday 7th May 2025

Our main topics for the summer terms are 'Dangerous Dinosaurs' and 'Big Wide World'. All Things Wild offers a unique mix of animals from around the world, grouped into the continents in which they live, plus life-sized dinosaur models, fossil digs and a trail to explore the timeline of the dinosaurs. We have also arranged a talk to find out more about how dinosaurs lived, the differences between herbivores and carnivores, how dinosaurs became extinct and spotting similarities between dinosaurs and modern-day birds and reptiles.

The trip will be a day to remember from start to finish, as we will be travelling to All Things Wild by train! We are asking parents to drop their child at Charlbury Train station at 8.45am for the 9.01am train to take us to Honeybourne, which is a short walk from All Things Wild. Mrs Percy, Mrs Kitto & Mrs Jobson will be at Charlbury station to greet the pupils.

Please can your child bring a packed lunch with plenty to drink, be dressed in full school uniform and have a rainproof jacket, or a sunhat and sunscreen (depending on the type of weather on the day), as the site is mostly outdoors. The return train is the 2.40pm from Honeybourne which gets into Charlbury at 3.08pm, which is when we are asking parents to collect from Charlbury.
