Every community has its own set of rules and ways to behave. It is important to follow the rules so that everyone can get along.

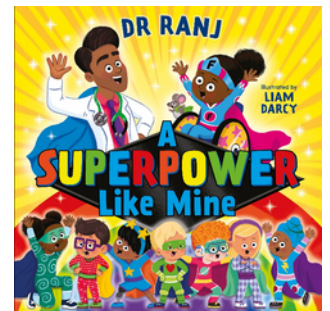
Community superheroes
