Modern Foreign Language Intent:

Our MFL curriculum, using the scheme 'La Jolie Ronde', is designed to progressively develop our children's skills in languages, through regular taught lessons and whole KS2 activities and opportunities. Children progressively learn, use, and apply phonics, acquire a growing bank of vocabulary, learn basic grammar and sentence structure all organised around topics, based on speaking, listening, reading, and writing. These approaches help equip our children to communicate, with the skills to be global citizens and to have a better understanding of languages as a linguist. The curriculum which runs on a two-year rolling programme, has been carefully designed and developed to ensure children learn the appropriate vocabulary enabling them to have a successful language learning experience enabling them to continue language learning in further education.

Our intent for MFL (French) is to provide pupils with opportunities to:

- develop an understanding and awareness of other cultures and languages,
- understand and respond to spoken and written language from a variety of authentic sources,
- speak with increasing confidence and spontaneity, finding ways of communicating what they want to say, including through discussions and asking questions, and continually improving the accuracy of their pronunciation and intonation,
- write at varying length, for different purposes and audiences, using the variety of grammatical structures that they have learnt,
- discover and develop an appreciation of a range of writing in the language studies.
